- Online Application Form (arch-gradapp.rice.edu)
- Application Fee (\$85 submitted online at completion of application)
- Three Letters of Evaluation (submitted electronically during online application)
- GRE Scores
 - Scores must be less than five years old and sent directly from ETS. In order for scores to arrive in time for consideration, you must take the GRE by October
 - No minimum score is required, however receiving scores in the 70th percentile for 2 of the 3 categories is strongly recommended
 - Institution Code and School Name: 6609 – Rice University
 - Department Code: 4401
- Option Selection: M.Arch. Option 1 or 2, or M.A. in Architecture Option 3
- “What’s at Stake?”
 - Please submit a short statement (one paragraph to one page) that articulates what you think is at stake for architecture today. Upload a PDF of this statement to the Admissions Document section of your online application.
- Curriculum Vitae
 - Submit a curriculum vitae (CV) that includes any information you think may be helpful to the admissions committee, such as projects undertaken, awards received, etc. Please explain your specific involvement if the item is not an individual achievement. Upload a PDF of your CV to the Admissions Document section of your online application.
- Digital Portfolio
 - M.Arch. Option 2 and M.A. in Architecture Option 3 applicant portfolios must include architectural projects from previous academic experience; Option 1 students may include architectural design work if possible, as well as documentation of any other design work (for example: photography, hand drawing, set design)
 - Portfolio must be uploaded as a PDF; it must be a single document no larger than 15 MB. File name must list program, option, last name, first name, portfolio; each field separated by an underscore (“_”) File naming example: MArch_Option1_Smith_Jane_Portfolio.pdf
- TOEFL Scores
 - Required of any student whose native language is not English
 - Exemptions include:
 - Proof of receiving a degree from an accredited US high school, college, or university
 - Proof of education in a country with English instruction including: Australia, Canada (English-speaking provinces), New Zealand, the United Kingdom or other countries with approval of Rice Architecture
 - Scores must be less than two years old and sent directly from ETS. In order for scores to arrive in time for consideration, you must take the TOEFL no later than October
 - Minimum acceptable is 100 on the Internet-based test
 - Institution Code and School Name: 6609 – Rice University
 - Department Code: 12

- One copy of the official, confidential transcript institution (undergraduate and graduate) where you:
 - Earned (or will earn) a degree
 - Studied for one year or more
 - Took classes that relate to your current application for graduate study
