Guest Juror Bios

Iñaki Alday is dean of the Tulane School of Architecture, co-director of the Yamuna River Project and, together with Margarita Jover, co-founder of aldayjover architecture and landscape.

Nerea Feliz Arrizabalaga is an Assistant Professor at the School of Architecture at the University of Texas at Austin and founder of Nerea Feliz Studio.

Michelle Addington is dean of The University of Texas at Austin School of Architecture. Formerly, she served as Gerald Hines Chair in Sustainable Architectural Design at the Yale University School of Architecture and was a Professor at Yale, GSD, the Technical University of Munich, Temple University, and Philadelphia University.

Garrett Finney was awarded the Rome Prize in Architecture in 1994. He is the founder and CEO of TAXA Inc. – which designs and manufactures innovative, forward looking mobile habitats. In previous lives he has been a Space Architect at NASA JSC, an architect, professor, blacksmith, industrial designer and home builder.

Craig Hartman is SOM's Senior Consulting Design Partner. His international work ranges from entire urban districts to singular works of civic, cultural, residential, commercial and academic architecture. His projects have been widely published and recognized and he is the 2017 William Bernoudy Architect in Residence at the American Academy in Rome.

Marcelo López-Dinardi is an immigrant, architect and educator interested in political economy and art/architecture practices. He is an Assistant Professor at Texas A&M and holds a M.S. in Critical, Curatorial and Conceptual Practices from Columbia GSAPP.

Francois de Menil is concerned with sustainability as well as with the social and cultural issues of how people live. He develops architectural solutions often through the use of narrative.

Sarah Nichols is an architect and lecturer at ETH Zurich. She is currently completing her dissertation and, together with Nils Havelka, a house in the Black Forest.

Guy Nordenson is a structural engineer and professor at Princeton University. He was the engineer at the Moody Center at Rice, the Menil Drawing Institute, and current MFAH expansion. Since 2008 he has led research projects on coastal resilience and climate adaptation and co-written three books on the subject.

Nat Oppenheimer is Executive Vice President of Robert Silman Associates. In addition to teaching at Princeton University since 2000, he has taught at Parsons School of Architecture and at Columbia University's Graduate School of Architecture & Engineering.

Ryan Roark works at LTL Architects and will be joining Rice as a visiting studio critic in spring 2019. She has an M. Arch. from Princeton and a PhD in research science from Cambridge.
