# Guest Juror Bios

**Cristobal Amunategui** is the co-founder of the office Amunategui Valdes and a doctoral candidate in architectural history and theory at Princeton University.

**José Aragüez** is an architect and writer based in New York City. He is Adjunct Professor of Architecture at Columbia University, where he leads graduate design studios and seminars.

**Katy Barkan** is principal of Los Angeles based practice Now Here, working on a range of speculative and built projects. She has been on the faculty of UCLA AUD since 2014.

**Daniel Cardoso Llach** is Assistant Professor at Carnegie Mellon University, where he chairs the Master of Science in Computational Design and teaches courses on the history, theory, and practice of design technologies.

**Michael Kubo** is Assistant Professor of Architectural History and Theory at the Gerald D. Hines College of Architecture and Design, U of H.

**Jeannette Kuo** is co-founding principal of Karamuk Kuo Architects based in Zurich and Assistant Professor in Practice at Harvard Graduate School of Design where she has taught since 2016.
