Guest Juror Bios

Ross Exo Adams is an assistant professor and co-director of architecture at Bard College. He is the author of *Circulation and Urbanization* (Sage, 2019) and has written widely on the intersections of architecture and urbanism with political geography and environmental humanities.

Andrew Atwood is an architect based in Los Angeles. He teaches design at UC Berkeley.

Kelly Bair is partner at BairBalliet, a research and design firm located in Chicago and Los Angeles, director of graduate studies and an associate professor at the University of Illinois at Chicago's School of Architecture. She is co-founder of Possible Mediums, a collaborative of fellow designers and educators

Rafael Beneytez is an associate professor and director of undergraduate architecture at the University of Houston. He is a principal at Z4Z4. His practice spans the fields of architecture design, architecture technology, and architecture theory.

Karolina Czekczek is a principal at Only If architecture office based in New York. The practice is engaged in a range of design work from a single- and multi-family housing prototypes to larger-scale urban design, research, and speculation.

Jeff Halstead is a lecturer at the University of Michigan, Taubman College of Architecture and Urban Planning.
