

OVERVIEW

The Rice Architecture Summer Immersion is a hands-on workshop open to high school students who have an interest in applying to architecture school. You will be introduced to principles of architecture and design. We will test design concepts through several media and exercises in two and three dimensions. Our goal is to explore architectural space, and to produce creative works that can be integrated in a design portfolio, a necessary component in the college application process for architecture programs. Participants will have the opportunity to interact with Rice faculty and current students, as well as practicing architects, to learn more about architecture.

PROGRAM STRUCTURE

The Rice Architecture Summer Immersion is a 13-day/12-night residential camp for current 10th and 11th grade students who are age 16 or older from targeted schools in the greater Houston area. Participants will stay in a dorm room and have a roommate. All campers will be in the same dorm building. Program staff members will be available at all hours in case of emergencies. Students are expected to stay on campus for the whole period, and to engage actively throughout the camp. The program, including room and board, is offered free of charge to accepted students.
